**AN RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CROSS ROADS, TEXAS, CANCELING THE MAY 9, 2009 ELECTION FOR TOWN OFFICERS AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE; ORDERING THE POSTING OF THIS RESOLUTION AT EACH POLLING PLACE ON ELECTION DAY; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 9, 2009, the Town Council ordered an election to be held on May 9, 2009, for the purpose of electing three council members to serve on the town council; and

**WHEREAS**, no proposition is to appear on the ballot in said general election; and

**WHEREAS**, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy have passed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has received the Town Secretary's written certification that each candidate is unopposed for the election; and

**WHEREAS**, in these circumstances, Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the general election. Now Therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CROSS  
ROADS, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2009, general election, are hereby declared elected to the specified offices and shall be issued a certificate of election:

Virden Seybold, Councilmember, and  
Steve Smith, Councilmember, and  
Becky Porter, Councilmember.

**SECTION 2.** The Town Secretary is directed to post a copy of this resolution at each designated polling place on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

**SECTION 3.** That all provisions of the resolutions of the Town of Cross Roads in conflict with the provisions of this resolution by the same are hereby repealed and all other provisions of the resolutions of the Town of Cross Roads not in conflict with the provisions of this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** That if any section, paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this resolution be adjusted or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this resolution or any other provision of the resolutions of the Town of Cross Roads.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is accordingly so resolved.
