8. Discussion of current public safety services.
Wallace stated NEPD services are not a concern and only the future of their facility needs attention at this time. The fire services are good, yet the response times and costs are a concern. The ambulance services are most critical in regards to response times, particularly to the southern part of town. He would like the board to research alternatives for fire and paramedic ambulance services.
9. Discussion of current and future public safety needs.
 - **Phillips stated that as the town grows routes of first responders is crucial.**
 - **Sweeney thanked Mayor Parrent for Krugerville offering the NEPD a building.**
 - **Wallace recommended North Texas Council of Governments (NTCOG) in regards to finding good information relating to growth and development.**
10. Discussion of prioritization of PSAB efforts.
 - **Wallace stated the priority should be emergency paramedic services, followed by fire, then PD.**
 - **Brown agreed first priority would be EMT and fire services, as the PD building is taken care of in the immediate future.**
 - **Phillips stated projecting and planning for growth and considering commercial guests is important.**

- Vaughn mentioned different EMS options and stated private service might be an option.

Vaughn will explore private paramedic ambulance options.

Wallace will explore public paramedic ambulance and fire services options.
